It is said to be a highly secure system driven through a browser based interface to increase efficiency, reduce administration costs and speed up processing of ID cards. New thicker and harder cards with magnetic strips and holograms are produced by the system and the advanced holographic images offer added protection against forgery, as well as making the cards more visible when shown at a distance. “The system supports ID strip readers for checking identities. The cards will also be used to identify voters,” said EastNets sales manager, Fahed Abu Hejleh. The system can also be easily updated at a later stage to introduce chip and fingerprint based cards.

Over 75 Zebra Card Printers are being used for the production of the national ID cards across the EastNets Bitaqat-e system, and with numbers of card expected to reach over 1 million every year, they will certainly be fully utilised.
