The SlatWall panels are the perfect accompaniment for eco-friendly furnishings and home styling. This popular design used over 3 million recycled plastic bottles in 2021 to create the PET felt used for the acoustic backing that provides class A absorption.

Available with free delivery within the UK, a minimum of 70% of all packaging is recyclable with any factory cardboard waste going straight to the recycling factory.
