Victoria Atkin explains how you can best use shelving units to free up space: **“Declutter a cramped room to make it appear larger and free up the floor area. The right choice of storage is key – opt for an open shelving unit with a minimalist frame, which keeps the wall space visible and adds to a tidy, uninterrupted scheme.”**

She adds, **“Choose a larger unit than you think you might need, and place accessories sparingly to maintain a flowing display that draws, but doesn’t pause, the eye. For maximum effect, pick a unit crafted from light, organic materials like natural wood to create a clean, nature-inspired feel that will instantly uplift a tired space.”**



For a luxe lift, the Balzac side table looks effortlessly chic when paired with lighter pink or cinnamon tones, such as the Calvin Armchair in Terracotta Velvet and Linen. The Ida Wall Mirror is made from antique brass and iron and would easily become the focal point within any room. These delectable hues give a comforting hug when the nights start to turn a little cooler.
