Guests can indulge in seasonal festive delights, from wild mushroom and rocket quiche; turkey, celeriac remoulade and cranberry sauce on brown bread; smoked salmon, caviar, horseradish cream on malted bread; egg truffle mayo and chives on pain de mie (V); chestnut and Montgomery cheddar Yorkshire pudding (V); to classic Afternoon Tea delicacies, such as freshly baked plain and spiced gingerbread scones and cornish clotted cream and blackberry jam. An assortment of festive teas, cakes and pastries are also available, such as the hotel's signature GSY bûche de Noël Spiced Jivara chocolate and bergamot teacake; a Christmas tree tart; chestnut and cassis Mont Blanc Black Forest reindeer Kalingo chocolate; and Amarena mousse.
