

Travelling to Cisco House

We strongly advise **all guests to travel to the Cisco House via public transport.**

Restrictions are now in place on coaches and cars within the Westfield area and there are no drop off or collection points close to the Cisco House. Parking is restricted to authorised personnel approved by LOCOG only. These are LOCOG restrictions, out of the control of Cisco.

To get to the house please follow the directions below. Please note that **Cisco House is NOT within the Westfield shopping centre (it is on the rooftop of one of the buildings outside the centre itself)** therefore please stay outside of the centre when following the directions and **DO NOT walk within the mall.**

You will also see people on the way holding signs for Cisco, Centurion Lounge and Sky News – they are there to help and can direct you to the house.

Please remember to bring your email invitation with you which you can show to security on arrival.

Directions to Cisco House from Stratford Rail and underground stations:

Stratford underground station serves the following lines: Jubilee, Central, Overground and DLR lines.

1. When exiting the underground lines (Jubilee, Central, Overground or DLR) or National Rail follow signs for **Westfield Shopping Centre/ Olympic Park**, you can travel above ground or under the railway lines using the tunnel.

You will then either arrive at the ground level of the shopping centre (please proceed to step 2) or if you take the main Town Centre exit from the underground station then you will need to cross the walkway bridge / take the underground tunnel which will be clearly visible when you exit the station. Once you cross the bridge please follow step 3.

2. Please take the **outside** escalators or lift to upper level by 'The Street' shopping area – **do not enter the Westfield shopping centre**. Marks and Spencer (a retail store – as shown on map) will then be on your left hand side and Forever 21 (a retail store) will be on your right hand side.
3. Please walk ahead down 'The Street'. At Samsung (retail shop - as shown on map) please bear right. Carry on walking, you will then see the Digital Fountain (as shown on map) ahead of you, continue forward. Holiday Inn (as shown on map) will soon be on your left.
4. Turn left at the Digital Fountain and you will see the Olympic Park straight ahead with The Cow Pub (as shown on map) on your left.
5. When you reach the end of the road turn right and walk ahead, there you will find the security entrance and lifts up to Cisco House.

Directions to Cisco House from Stratford International station:

58 trains per hour stop at Westfield Stratford City's two railway stations. This includes high-speed services from Stratford International, connecting you directly to London St Pancras (for the Eurostar) and stations in Kent via the high speed rail line HS1 (High-Speed 1)

1. From the International Station walk around the outside of the shopping centre.
2. Walk towards Jamie's Italian restaurant, turn left and then continue forward to the Digital Fountain ahead of you.
3. Turn left at the Digital Fountain and you will see the Olympic Park straight ahead.
4. When you reach the road turn right and walk forward, there you will find the security entrance and lifts up to Cisco House.

Travelling to Cisco House via bus

The new bus interchange, built for the launch of Westfield Stratford City, connects the neighbouring boroughs of Newham, Leyton, Hackney and Tower Hamlets via the 97, 241, 339 and D8 buses. The bus station can be found next to the underground tube station.
